He advises national governments and industry across the world on public sector reforms and has been instrumental in structuring flagship public-private partnerships in the UK, EU and overseas.

Professor Christopher Bovis is a leading authority in public procurement and public-private partnerships and specializes in anti-trust law and policy, with particular emphasis on public sector management. He has acted on behalf of governments, the defence sector and industry on numerous high profile projects

He has published extensively in international legal and management journals and has produced 74 books, monographs and articles on European and business subjects. His academic work has been translated into different languages, including Chinese, French and German.

He is Managing Editor of the *European Public Private Partnerships Law Review*, published by Lexxion.
