CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

6. Description of the contract

Road refurbishment works on the national road no. 5312. as follows:

- sheet correction and pavement reinforcement works between 65+017 - 65+610 km sections.

- sheet correction and pavement reinforcement works between km sections 64+384 - - 65+017

- pavement reinforcement works between km sections 64+000 - 64+384

The available financial resources: 590.551 EUR without VAT.

7. Number and titles of lots

Lot1: pavement reinforcement works between km sections 64+000 - 64+384, permit is not necessary

Lot 2: sheet correction and pavement reinforcement works between km sections 64+384 - - 65+017, permit required

Lot 3: sheet correction and pavement reinforcement works between 65+017 - 65+610 km sections, permit required.

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers] which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 22 below). All goods supplied under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed]

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide**.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

No tender guarantee is required.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 5% of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

13. Information meeting and/or site visit

No information meeting is planned.

14. Tender validity

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders.

15. Period of implementation of tasks

In case of each lot: The contract must be accomplished within 4 months as from the commencement order.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

1. Economic and financial capacity of candidate:

For tendering Lot 1:

- (a) The average annual turnover of the tenderer in the past three years (2011, 2012 and 2013) must exceed the amount of EUR 100,000;

For tendering Lot 2:

- (a) The average annual turnover of the tenderer in the past three years (2011, 2012 and 2013) must exceed the amount of EUR 350,000;For tendering Lot 2:

For tendering Lot 3:

- (a) The average annual turnover of the tenderer in the past three years (2011, 2012 and 2013) must exceed the amount of EUR 350,000;

In case of tendering for more than one lot the above requirements should be added. E.g. in case of tendering for Lot 1 and Lot 2 the average annual turnover must be EUR 450.000, or if tendering for all of the lots the average annual turnover must be EUR 800.000 in the past 3 years.

2. Technical and professional capacity of candidate:

For tendering Lot 1 only:

- (a) The Tenderer has at least one employee with Msc or Bsc qualifications on the field of the technical sciences/engineering and with a minimum 36 month professional experience -gained after having the required qualifications- in the technical management of public road construction works. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when this project leader will have obtained the licence marked “MV-KÉ” according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or the “MV-KÉ/A” according to the 244/2006 (XII.) Government decree (or equivalent licence) and listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so.
- (b) The Tenderer has completed and ended -in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts- minimum one contract in the field of construction or reconstruction of roads in the total lengths of min. 300 m, within the period of five years before the deadline for submission of tenders. This means that the taking-over certificates of the works the tenderer refers to must have been issued within the indicated period. The criterion can be fulfilled both one or more reference contracts.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned;

- (c) The Tenderer has at least one level controlled asphalt finisher

For tendering Lot 2 only:

- (a) The Tenderer has at least one employee with Msc or Bsc qualifications on the field of the technical sciences/engineering and with a minimum 36 month professional experience -gained after having the required qualifications- in the technical management of public road construction works. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when this project leader will have obtained the licence marked “MV-KÉ” according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or the “MV-KÉ/A” according to the 244/2006 (XII.) Government decree (or equivalent licence) and listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so.
- (b) The Tenderer has completed and ended -in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts- minimum one contract in the field of construction or reconstruction of roads in the total lengths of min. 600 m, within the period of five years before the deadline for submission of tenders. This means that the taking-over certificates of the works the tenderer refers to must have been issued within the indicated period. The criterion can be fulfilled both one or more reference contracts.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned;

- (c) The Tenderer has at least one level controlled asphalt finisher

For tendering Lot 3 only:

- (a) The Tenderer has at least one employee with Msc or Bsc qualifications on the field of the technical sciences/engineering and with a minimum 36 month professional experience -gained after having the required qualifications- in the technical management of public road construction works. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when this project leader will have obtained the licence marked “MV-KÉ” according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or the “MV-KÉ/A” according to the 244/2006 (XII.) Government decree (or equivalent licence) and listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so.
- (b) The Tenderer has completed and ended -in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts- minimum one contract in the field of construction or reconstruction of roads in the total lengths of min. 550 m, within the period of five years before the deadline for submission of tenders. This means that the taking-over certificates of the works the tenderer refers to must have been issued within the indicated period. The criterion can be fulfilled both one or more reference contracts.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned;

- (c) The Tenderer has at least one level controlled asphalt finisher

In the case of tendering for more than one lot (either for 2 or for 3):

- (a) The Tenderer has at least one employee with Msc or Bsc qualifications on the

field of the technical sciences/engineering and with a minimum 36 month professional experience -gained after having the required qualifications- in the technical management of public road construction works. The completion of the contract shall only be commenced when this project leader will have obtained the licence marked “MV-KÉ” according to the Government decree 266/2013 (VII.11.) or the “MV-KÉ/A” according to the 244/2006 (XII.) Government decree (or equivalent licence) and listed in the register of the Hungarian Chamber of Engineers as so.

- (b) The Tenderer has completed and ended -in accordance with the prescriptions of the relevant contracts- minimum one contract in the field of construction or reconstruction of roads in the total lengths of min. 900 m, within the period of five years before the deadline for submission of tenders. This means that the taking-over certificates of the works the tenderer refers to must have been issued within the indicated period. The criterion can be fulfilled both one or more reference contracts.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to ask for copies of certificates of the taking over certificate / final acceptance signed by the supervisors/contracting authority of the project concerned;

- (c) The Tenderer has at least one level controlled asphalt finisher

And additionally, for tendering any of the Lots:

- (d) if it is a sole tenderer it must carry out at least 70 % of the contract works using its own resources, which means that it must have the equipment, materials, human and financial resources necessary to carry out that percentage of the contract.
- (e) if it is the lead member of a joint venture/consortium, it must be able to carry out at least 50 % of the contract works using its own means.

If a tender is submitted by a consortium, unless specified, the selection criteria listed above will be applied to the consortium as a whole.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacity of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. Some examples of when it may *not* be considered appropriate by the Contracting Authority are when the tenderer relies mostly on the capacity of other entities or when it relies on key criteria. **In the case of the present tender the reference criteria is deemed to be such criteria by the Contracting Authority, of which can not be provided by other entities.** If the tenderer relies on other entities, it must prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary to perform the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator. Furthermore, the tender should include a separate document providing data on this third entity for the relevant selection criterion. Proof of capacity must be furnished at the request of the Contracting Authority.
